COMMON COURSE NUMBERING

Beginning in Fall 2025 all California Community Colleges are to comply with Assembly Bill (AB) 1111, the Common Course Numbering (CCN) project, which requires colleges implement student-facing common course numbering. The CCN system will assign the same course number to comparable courses across all California Community Colleges in order to streamline transfer to four-year colleges and universities and reduce excess unit accumulation.

To date, three phases of CCN have been announced. Phase I begins in Fall 2025 and consists of six courses plus their honors course version. Refer to the chart below for the list of Phase I courses and their former Foothill course numbers and titles. Phase II and Phase III will begin in future catalog years.
